The candidate advised is directed to report for duty within 15 days from the date of receipt of this order, at the respective station with medical fitness certificate as prescribed in G.O.(P) No: 20/2011/P&ARD dated, 30.06.2011. In case of those candidates who fail to join duty within stipulated time, their appointment will be cancelled and the vacancy will be reported to Kerala Public Service Commission as "Not Joining Duty".

As per the Government Order read second above, Government has issued new guidelines for granting extension of time and reporting of NJD vacancies, in which the candidates who are pursuing PG Course will be granted 45 days of extension and thereafter they should join service and avail leave without allowances for completing the course.

The candidates should produce all relevant records in proof of date of birth, qualifications, Registration and Medical Fitness Certificate as prescribed in G.O.(P) No: 20/2011/P&ARD dated, 30.06.2011 obtained from a Medical Officer not below the rank of Assistant Surgeon in Government Service to Regional Deputy Director concerned, at the time of joining duty.

The extension of joining time will not be allowed without valid and specific reason.

In the case of candidates whose community is noted in the appointment order, community certificate from the competent authority should be produced.
